This bi-annual seminar, co-sponsored by seven Methodist-related institutions of higher learning in Britain, also marks the tenth anniversary of this collaborative effort. The seminars provide an opportunity for established and emerging scholars of Methodist Studies to present the findings of their research. We conceive of Methodist Studies broadly and aim to provide opportunities for students of history, theology, literature, art, material culture and other fields related to Methodism.

Whilst we hope to offer a hybrid event, at this time, the presentation of papers will all be delivered online so we welcome the submission of papers from all global settings. The seminar also occurs during the Centenary Year of Wesley House, so the seminar will have a celebratory as well as a scholarly ambiance, both in person and online. Given the fact that the date of the event corresponds with the 'conversion' of Charles Wesley, the event will close with a hymn-sing celebrating the global nature of his lyrical theology, with Wesley and other texts sung to different tunes from around the world.
